Knowledge Central is a richly integrated portal solution providing a central point of collaboration and knowledge. Designed to build a more agile organisation, the platform of Knowledge Central is a web based SharePoint portal integrated with the full range of Microsoft Office System products. In addition OBS scanned hardcopy documents and contracts

into electronic document format and saved these into SharePoint sites allowing ease of access as well as search, auditing and workflow to be applied across the documents and contracts.

Primelife now has a secure document repository called "Primelife Central" with powerful information aggregation and advanced document management features. Primelife Central provides presence awareness eliminating delays in locating and communicating with other users, as well as electronic forms which enable Primelife to collect and distribute data for purchase orders and job vacancies.
