Bayside Health now uses its Microsoft project management system to track tasks and resources, manage documents, integrate its project management methodology, allocate issues to resource owners, link risks to tasks and institute Web-based collaboration for resource management.

Bayside Health is a large public sector organisation that encompasses The Alfred Hospital, Sandingham & District Memorial Hospital and Caulfield General Medical Centre. Across its three hospitals, Bayside Health's services include trauma, aged care, emergency, rehabilitation, infectious diseases, oncology, psychiatry and intensive care. The Alfred Hospital also has a distinguished history of medical training and research.

Bayside were introduced to OBS by HP, its managed services provider, and OBS as an expert in portals and collaboration on the Microsoft platform was the partner on the Bayside Health implementation.

Bayside Health wanted to automate the tracking of tasks, issues and resources and install a central repository of project and resource data that was available via the Web. Using the existing features of Microsoft Project 2002 and leveraging the Microsoft Office model and Windows SharePoint Services, the new platform at Bayside Health ensures that project team members are fully aware of the status of each project in which they are involved, the tasks assigned to them and the risks and issues these tasks carry. This solution provides structure for all the project managers so they can work together in a more cooperative environment. Team members now have unprecedented project visibility as well as an audit trail of their involvement.
